## Jazz Ensemble I Auditions 2018

### Information about Auditions

- Practice Sessions & Help will be provided to band students between 7:00am-7:50am on September 5 & 6.
- Auditions will be held on September 7, 10, & 11. Sign up for an audition time inside the band room. Be sure you have the audition handout for your instrument.
- Results will be posted at the end of school on Friday September 12th.
- Students who make it into the ensemble will start rehearsing as a full ensemble on September 14th. Mr. Stai will contact the counseling office to make sure that the jazz class is added to the student's schedules.
- Jazz Ensemble I will meet every morning from 7:00am-7:50am.
- Jazz Ensemble I auditions are for enthusiastic musicians who are committed to preparing their parts and showing up on time and ready to play every rehearsal and every gig!
- Jazz Ensemble I is a graded class.

### Things we'll be listening for

- **Confidence** - Did you show up on time, prepared, and ready to give your best.
- **Assigned Prepared Pieces** - Work up the prepared pieces to the best of your ability in one week. Think about key signature, steady tempo, and style.
- **Your Choice Prepared Piece** - During jazz auditions, you will have the opportunity to perform something extra. Pick something that you are comfortable with that showcases your talents.
- **See the reverse side** of this handout for extra tips & notes specific to the instrument you are auditioning on.
- **Lessons** - Be sure to mention if you are taking lessons or went a jazz camp or played in a combo group over the summer. These decisions show a lot of dedication & determination.

### Saxes & Brass:

- Scales - Major, Minor, Dominant 7, B-flat & F Blues. Show me how much you can perform.

- Optional - Solo over a backing track or Aebersold recording.
- What I am listening for:
  - Appropriate Jazz Style.
  - Articulation should be clear and appropriate.
  - Beautiful Tone.
  - Musical shape & line. Play the music like you listen to jazz and know the language.

**Drums:**

- NAFME All NW Audition Packet
- What I am listening for:
  - Appropriate Style
  - Consistent Time & Rhythm
  - Kicks, hits & fills
  - Balance between all drumset components

**Piano:**

- Demonstrate major and minor scales, 2 hands, 2 octaves. If Possible, demonstrate ability to read chord symbols, showing knowledge of major, minor and dominant 7 (or 9s) chords, at least in root position.
- Using both hands, demonstrate major, minor and dominant chords (all keys) in root position, 1st and 2nd inversions, and root position without the root. If possible, demonstrate 2 handed "open" voicings of major, minor and dominant chords, if possible.

- Optional –Solo over a backing track or Aebersold recording.
- What I am listening for:
  - Appropriate Style.
  - Articulation should be clear and appropriate.
  - Consistent Time & Rhythm
  - Musical shape & line. Play the music like you listen to jazz and know the language.

**Guitar:**

- Demonstrate pentatonic scales, as well as scale patterns for major and minor scales.
- Demonstrate major, minor and dominant chords, at least 2 different voicings for each chord.
- Play a basic 12 bar blues chord progression (Either in key of F or B-flat).

- Optional –Solo over a backing track or Aebersold recording.
- What I am listening for:
  - Appropriate Style.
  - Articulation should be clear and appropriate.
  - Consistent Time & Rhythm
  - Musical shape & line. Play the music like you listen to jazz and know the language.

**Bass:** *Being able to play both upright and electric bass is huge.*

- Demonstrate pentatonic scales, as well as scale patterns for major and minor scales.
- Demonstrate a simple 12 bar blues walking bass line (Either in key of F or B-flat). Demonstrate ability to keep your place while reading chords by walking using roots and 5ths; keep a steady tempo.

- Optional –Solo over a backing track or Aebersold recording.

  - Appropriate Style.
  - Articulation should be clear and appropriate.
  - Consistent Time & Rhythm
  - Musical shape & line. Play the music like you listen to jazz and know the language.
